1ST LEG SQUASH 2018 (20th APRIL to 22nd 2018)

“CREATING OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUNG TALENTS”

GENERAL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

1) Objective :

The Selangor Super Junior Circuit (SSJC) is to provide exposure to all Selangor players under age group Categories 9, 11 & 13 only. This circuit is to provide more competitive tournament opportunities to young players who do not get selected to play in the CIMB tournaments.

2) Number of Legs/ Dates & Venue:

This tournament is held for the 1st time in 2018 and will be divided into 2 Legs.

i. 1st Leg –20th to 22nd Apr 2018

Venue- Lakeview Club, Subang Jaya

ii. 2nd Leg –18th to 20th August 2018

Venue to be confirmed later

3) Age Cut Off Date –

1st January 2018

Individual Boys Event Under 9, 11 & 13

Individual Girls Event Under 9, 11 & 13

5) Competition Format

6) Draw Size and Entry

32 Draws

7) SCORING & FORMAT/ MARKING AND REFEREEING

- a. For all categories up to Under 13 all matches will be circuit format at 11 points – PAR (Point – A – Rally)
- b. All top 16 players in point (a) will be playing the best of 5 matches. Any other placing will be playing the best of 3.
- c. All players are required to referee and mark.
- d. Players who refuse to do so will be disqualified from the tournament.

8) SELECTION OF PLAYERS:

- a. ONLY OPEN TO ALL SELANGOR PLAYERS REGISTERED WITH SRAS. New players welcomed as long as registered as New Junior Members with SRAS.
- b. Selangor players whose position is 5th onwards in 2015 Selangor State Closed Results are encouraged to participate. (*That means Top 4 for these 6 category groups are "refrained" from participating*)
- c. The continuity of this tournament in the following year also depends on the participation level of Selangor players.

9) ENTRANCE FEES

- i. RM 30 – for all current Junior Members.
- ii. RM45 – for all newly registered Junior Members.

10) ENTRY FORM & PAYMENT OF FEES:

- a. Please email official entry form to srasjdp (srasjdp@gmail.com)
- b. Entries must be received by **10th April 2018 (Tuesday)**.
- c. Late entries will not be entertained. Kindly submit through your centres via your Coach/ Club. Individual entries can be submitted directly to the above email address
- d. Kindly pay your tournament fees on time to your Coaches.
- e. Payment of fees compiled by Coaches must be submitted to Lim Wei Jie/ SRASJDP before tournament date.

11) PLAYER WITHDRAWAL:

No withdrawals will be allowed after the draw is out. Any withdrawals thereafter will not be refunded. Please notify SRASJDP on any withdrawals before the Draw date.

12) MATCHES:

- a. Match schedules, court allocations and updated draws will be made available at the tournament control centre.
- b. Please refer to the match number references to confirm the courts and estimated time of the matches.
- c. Please note the scheduled match times are estimates only. Be sure to be available at least an hour before your match is scheduled.

- d. At the end of the day the finalised match schedule and the results for the day will be updated in the "Tournament Software"
- e. The organizer reserves the right to change courts and schedules whenever necessary for the smooth running of the tournament.

13) EYEWEAR

- a. Protective eye-wear must be worn at all times when in court, whether during practice or tournament play.
- b. Failure to do so may result in the player being disqualified from the tournament.

14) TOURNAMENT ENTRY GOODIES-

- a. To be decided and finalised.
- b. Certificate to be presented for participants who entered 2 legs at the end of SSJC 2nd Leg

15) TOURNAMENT ORGANIZATION (Venue: Lakeview)

- Schedule will be informed once the draw is out about 5 days before tournament commences.
- All Games/ matches will follow through.
- Please refer to your Coaches should you have any enquiries. Your Coach or Club will liaise directly with Tournament Organiser/ Coordinators.

SRAS CODE OF CONDUCT DURING TOURNAMENTS:

The Player/ Participant should:

- Abide by Team Organiser rules set for this tournaments and be punctual for first day tournament briefing.
- Treat everyone equally regardless of age, ability, gender, race, religion, ethnic origin, social
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the context of squash
- Know and abide by the rules of the game
- Accept the referee's decision without question or complaint (let the captain or coach ask the necessary questions).
- Use appropriate language among team mate and towards coaches and team officials
- Not make sexually suggestive comments/ actions towards another team mate or official, even in fun, Avoid violence and rough play
- Abide by the Tournament guidelines briefly explained by Tournament Referee and strictly follow through those rules in the Spirit of the game.
- Help injured players and opponents where appropriate
- **Keep to agreed timings for competitions** or inform their coach or team manager if and when there is an emergency. Player will be blacklisted from future tournaments if they pull out or walkover without valid reasons.

- Wear suitable kit/ clothing including SRAS approved eye protection during competition.
- NOT run around during tournaments / loiter away from tournament area
- Be involved in group time for promotional activities by SRAS

The Tournament Referee has the right to mete out disciplinary actions on :

- A participant who verbally or physically abuses his opponent, the Marker, Referee, officials, spectators or sponsors.
 - A participant who uses profane language or offensive gestures
 - A participant who abuses playing equipment or vandalises the squash court.
 - A participant who fails to attend the competition without valid reason after accepting invitation to play per scheduled Draw.
 - A participant who fails to complete a match for a reason other than injury, illness or emergency situation (need to provide medical cert.).
 - A participant who fails to make himself/ herself available to meet reasonable request for interviews or photo session by media.
- ❖ Note – The Organiser reserves the Right to amend any Rules during the tournament without any prior notice
