Entry Procedure

- i) All entries must be registered through affiliated state associations (SRAM Affiliates). It is the responsibility of the state association to register via Online Entry System at <http://www.cdmr.com/sramreg/Account/Login.aspx>.
- ii) All players need to register for MYSPIN before submitting entry for the tournament. MYSPIN is not applicable to foreign players.
- iii) Closing date for entries is **21 days** prior to commencement of the tournament. Late entries shall not be accepted.
- iv) SRAM will have the following **48 hours** to invite states to fill remaining vacant slots if any.

- v) Players may opt to play in higher age categories but are not allowed to return to their original age category or move to a higher age category in the following legs.
- vi) SRAM has the authority to select the age categories for any player.
- vii) SRAM will accommodate as many PAX entries as possible subject to constraints of the draws.

Entry fees for RSNJC 2017

- i) Foreign players are **eligible** to participate in the **CIMB NJC**.
- ii) All foreign entries **MUST** be submitted through their National bodies
- iii) Foreign Players Entry Fees: USD100 per player (excluding accommodation)
- iv) **Local Players Entry Fees: Free (sponsored players) and RM50 (Pax account players)**
- v) Foreign players are **eligible** to participate in the **CIMB NJC** provided that they are normally resident in Malaysia. SRAM may require proof of residence
- vi) **All entry fees are to be bank into SRAM Account before the tournament begin. Entry fees will no longer be collected during tournaments. Please ensure that all fees are paid before the tournament begin to ensure unwanted issue to happen. Please provide us with the slip of payment once you have transferred the money into the account.**

Funding

- i) **NJC** - SRAM will fund **up to a maximum of 3 players per age category** and up to **4 Officials** for the 1st and 2nd Leg. (The Official to Player Ratio is 1 Official for every 5 players)
- ii) Players selected by the states to be sponsored under SRAM's quota must be the **top 4 ranked in** their age group in their state. They must be a **registered junior member of the state** with a MYSPIN number.
- iii) All additional players shall be on pax account.
- iv) Outstation players who are not funded by SRAM (PAX account players) are to pay a total fee of **RM180 to SRAM inclusive of the entry fee (RM50)** inclusive of internal transport and accommodation only. (Subject to change based on hotel rates)
- v) SRAM Funding includes transportation, accommodation and meal allowance. Meal Allowance will be given to sponsored players and officials only. Meal Allowance is capped at **RM15.00 per player/per coach per day (RM5.00 per meal)**. The Meal Allowance is paid in proportion to the number of meals required during the tournament. e.g. on the final day, lunch is provided so the only meal allowance payable is RM5 for breakfast on that day.
- vi) 80% of the total Meal Allowance will be given before the tournament begin to each state and balance 20% will be given during the tournament.

- vii) Transportation claims will be based on **bus rates** for **West Malaysia** and airfare with a ceiling of **RM350.00** for **East Malaysia**

Rules and Regulation

- i. Participants and officials must arrive **15 minutes** before the tournament starts for the briefing session.
- ii. Participants must ensure that they are **on time for their matches**.
- iii. **It is compulsory for all participants to mark or referee matches when called upon to do so.** Failure to do so may result in the player being suspended from competitions. All State Coaches and Managers are responsible for enforcing this. Failure to comply will result in disciplinary action against the player and the SSRA.
- iv. Participants must wear the **main sponsor's T-Shirt** during the **press conference** and **prize giving ceremony**. Players who are not properly attired (must wear shoes) shall not be allowed to receive their medals and prizes.
- v. This year SRAM wants all participants, officials and spectators to help us to Go Green. One of the biggest forms of pollution in our oceans is plastic and disposable plastic drinking water bottles is one of the most widespread pollutants.

So from this year onwards, disposable plastic water bottles are strongly discouraged at all SRAM tournament venues.

Please assist us by not bringing disposable plastic bottles into the venue. Instead please bring your own water container. SRAM has made provision for ample hot and cold water dispensers to be available for you at WATER STATIONS throughout the venue.

Scoring Sytem

- i. The tournament is based on a circuit format
- ii. 11 points - PAR (Point A Rally)
- iii. Best of five games format for:
CIMB NJC: Top 16
- iv. All other placing matches shall be a best of three games format.
- v. Entries are limited to 64 Draws
- vi. All Rounds are played Top Down except for the Final Round which shall be played Bottom Up
- vii. Age categories will be played in ascending order: Eg: U15, U17, U19
